**PROPER UNIFORMS ARE ESSENTIAL**  
 The complete Scout Uniform, consisting of a Scout shirt & Scout pants, belt, buckle and socks are required for all applicants. A course t-shirt, neckerchief and slide will be provided at the course.

**PHYSICAL HEALTH**  
 A current Annual Health and Medical Record form is required, Parts A, B, and C, with the necessary examiner's signature, no later than May 12, 2017 with the rest of your paperwork.

**LOCATION**  
 The National Youth Leadership Training Course will be held at Camp McLoughlin at Lake of the Woods, Oregon. Detailed instructions, directions to camp, arrival and departure times, and required forms will be sent to each Scout when his registration is received.

**COURSE COST**  
 The course fee is \$245. This covers the cost of food, facility, insurance, training materials, course T-shirt, neckerchief and slide. A \$75 deposit for each nominee is required. The deposit is transferable, but **NOT REFUNDABLE AFTER a Scout has been accepted for NYLT.** Deposits for Scouts **not accepted** will be refunded in full. Fees paid beyond the deposit will not be refundable after May 26th, but also can be transferred to another Scout. Camperships are available, using the Opportunity Fund Application. ## NATIONAL YOUTH LEADERSHIP TRAINING COURSE 2017

**N**YLT is a proven exciting, action-packed program designed to provide youth members of the BSA with leadership skills and experience they can use in their home Troops. The six day National Youth Training Conference is the most advanced Scout leadership program offered by the Crater Lake Council and the Boy Scouts of America.

The NYLT course centers around the concepts of what a leader must BE, what he must KNOW, and what he must DO. The key elements are then taught with a clear focus on HOW TO. The skills come alive during the week as the patrol goes on a Quest for the Meaning of Leadership.

### NYLT SUBJECTS

**S**kills of Leadership... are designed to give participants a toolbox of effective leadership skills they can make their own. Through presentations and positive experiences in goal setting, planning and problem solving, participants learn how to set a clear course toward their team and individual vision.

Leadership, fun, challenge, adventure - NYLT offers all of those and much more. The program can be a centerpiece of a youth's training, providing local Troops with outstanding youth leaders and giving those Scouts the tools and leadership ideals that will serve them well in Scouting and life.

### REQUIREMENTS TO PARTICIPATE...

1. **Rank:** must be First Class Rank or above and be a living example of the Scout Oath and Law. **No discipline problems please.**
2. **Leadership:** hold, or be eligible for election to, a responsible leadership position such as Patrol Leader, Senior or Assistant Senior Patrol Leader, or Junior Assistant Scoutmaster.
3. **Camping and Cooking Experience:** participants are encouraged to have at least 15 nights of Troop camping. Must have outdoor patrol cooking experience.
4. **Age:** must be at least 13 years old and have completed the 7<sup>th</sup> grade by June 2017.
5. **Registration:** every participant must be recommended by his Scoutmaster to ensure he is mature and responsible enough to benefit from NYLT. **Each Scout should have the desire to attend this course.**

**Why All These Requirements?** The conference includes classroom sessions as well as application experience. A successful participant must be ready to participate in an experience where he will be teamed with new Scouts in a patrol. Scouts who still need to be with buddies from home and familiar adults will simply not be ready for this learning environment. Scouts will be camping and cooking as patrols for the full week. Scouts with discipline problems will be sent home without a refund.
