Hiking and camping without a trace are signs of an expert outdoorsman and of a Scout or Scouter who cares for the environment. Leave No Trace is an awareness and an attitude rather than a set of rules- it applies in our backyard or local park as much as in the backcountry. Leave No Trace is a key aspect of modern outdoor Scouting.

The Leave No Trace program is the tool we use in scouting to help teach young people cutting edge outdoor skills, ethical decision making, and practical outdoor citizenship. Instruction and practice of Leave No Trace is integrated into BSA youth advancement and awards programs, and our major training events. Leave No Trace is included in our Cub Scout, Boy Scout and Venturing Handbooks along with the BSA Fieldbook.

This Leave No Trace Master Educator Course provides supplemental Scouting information that prepares graduates by instructing the why and the practical skills relating to the principles of Leave No Trace. Graduating Leave No Trace Masters are welcome to provide this instruction outside of Scouting as well.

All BSA Master Educator courses are taught by nationally designated Master Educator Instructors. Your Master Educator standing is recognized internationally by the Leave No Trace Center for Outdoor Ethics.

- Prerequisite: BSA registered adult leaders and Venturers (age 18 and older) with a current BSA Annual Health and Medical Record parts A, B & C. This course is a backpacking trek. Participants should be capable of carrying a 30-40 pound backpack a few miles each day at an elevation of 5,000 to 7,500 feet. This course teaches advanced leave no trace skills and ethics, and assumes you are already a well-seasoned and accomplished backcountry camper. Basic camping skills are not taught.

Camp Makualla is on Crescent Lake off of Highway 58 in Central Oregon. Being a sub-Alpine environment located in the Cascade Range expect cool nights and possible fire restrictions. There is no Wi-Fi and limited cell service at Camp Makualla, and generally no cell service in the backcountry.
